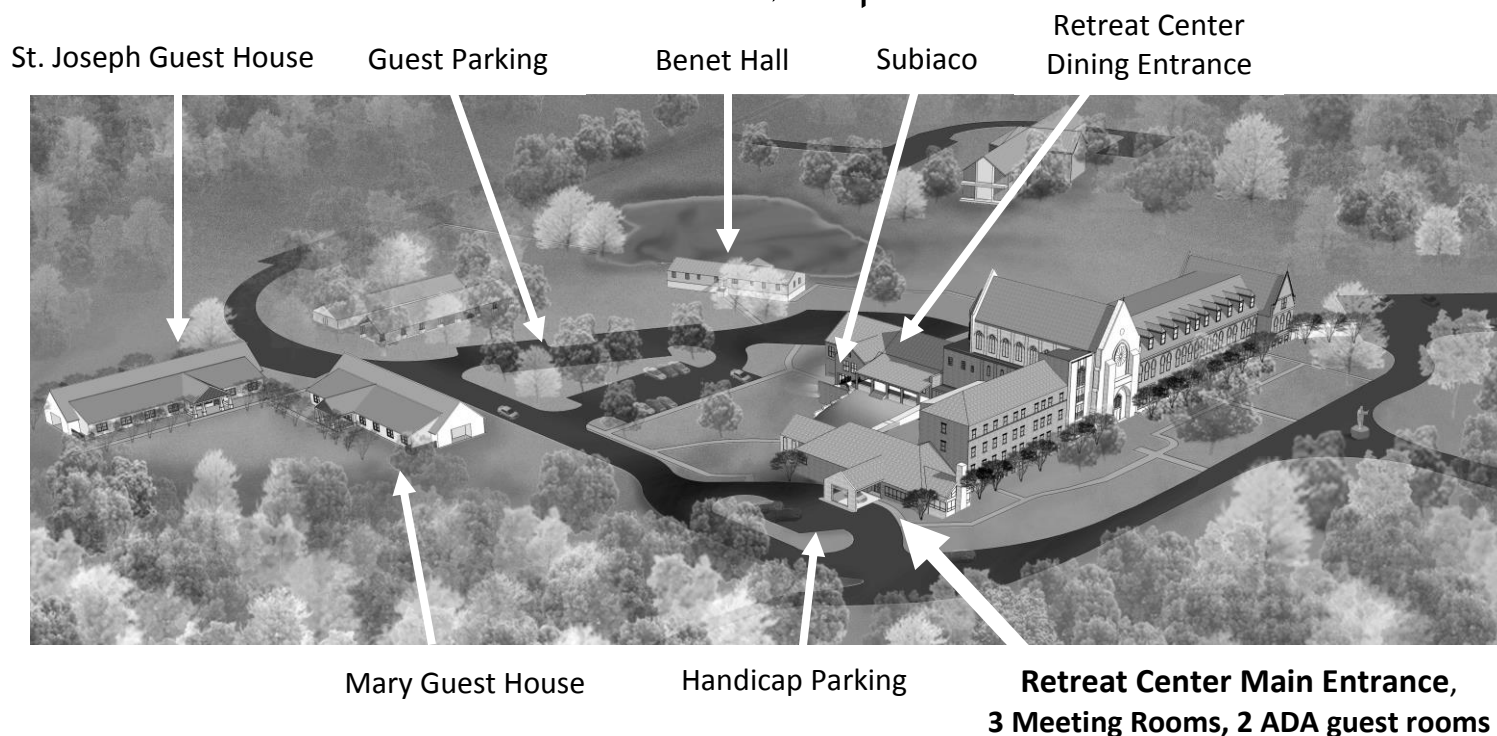


Benedictine Sisters Retreat Center Site Map



Description of Overnight Guest Accommodations

Mary Guest House and St. Joseph Guest House

Each guest house features:

- Twelve double-occupancy guest rooms with private bath (*one guest room in each building meets ADA requirements*)
- Spacious living room/gathering space with comfortable furnishings
- Kitchenette with refrigerator, microwave, coffee maker, and dining table
- Storm refuge rooms
- Pleasant front porch with lovely, pastoral views
- Convenient parking and access to meeting areas
- Complementary Wi-Fi access in the gathering space

Subiaco

A dedicated area for private retreatants

- 5 private rooms with private bath
- Common living room and kitchenette
- Complementary Wi-Fi access

Annunciata Hall

- 2 single-occupancy ADA-rooms, each with private bath
- Convenient (level and/or sloped) access to meeting and dining areas
- Complementary Wi-Fi access

Benet Hall

- Ranch-style house containing 18 beds in 11 guest rooms
- Four hallway baths
- Living room; kitchenette; front porch overlooking Lake Maurus

Meeting Room Descriptions

Three meeting rooms are available to meet the needs of groups of varying sizes.

St. Benedict (shaded **blue** on attached diagram)

Maximum Capacity: Approx. 100

Features: Generously-sized gathering space for larger groups; serving counter with sink for refreshment and beverage service; partition allows for dividing room into two smaller spaces.

St. Scholastica (shaded **green** on attached diagram)

Maximum Capacity: Approx. 60

Features: Ample seating for a medium-sized group with fireplace nook and expansive windows overlooking Novice's Park and Cemetery Road; serving counter with sink for refreshment and beverage service.

St. Gertrude (shaded **rose** on attached diagram)

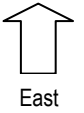
Maximum Capacity: Approx. 12

Features: Bright, sunny room ideal for a smaller gathering such as a prayer group or planning meeting

Additional features:

- Covered entrance for drop-off and unloading
- Convenient parking
- Complementary Wi-Fi
- Flexible meeting configurations ranging from auditorium style to classroom style
- Gift shop
- Convenient access to Retreat Center dining via indoor corridor or outdoor courtyard and porch
- Refrigerator for storage of beverages and snacks
- Comfortable sitting areas for visiting or relaxing
- Two handicap-accessible overnight guest rooms
- Handicap-accessible restroom adjacent to meeting areas
- Access to monastic library and spiritual direction rooms
- Staff offices located near meeting rooms for ready assistance with group needs
- A small prayer chapel is available for the use of all guests
- Complementary meeting equipment as available: podium, tripod presentation easel (without pad), tripod display easels, portable chalk board. One portable microphone/amplifier unit is available.
- Equipment available for a small usage fee includes flat-screen monitor with DVD player on portable cart, laptop computer, CD player, tripod flip chart presentation easel with flip pads provided.

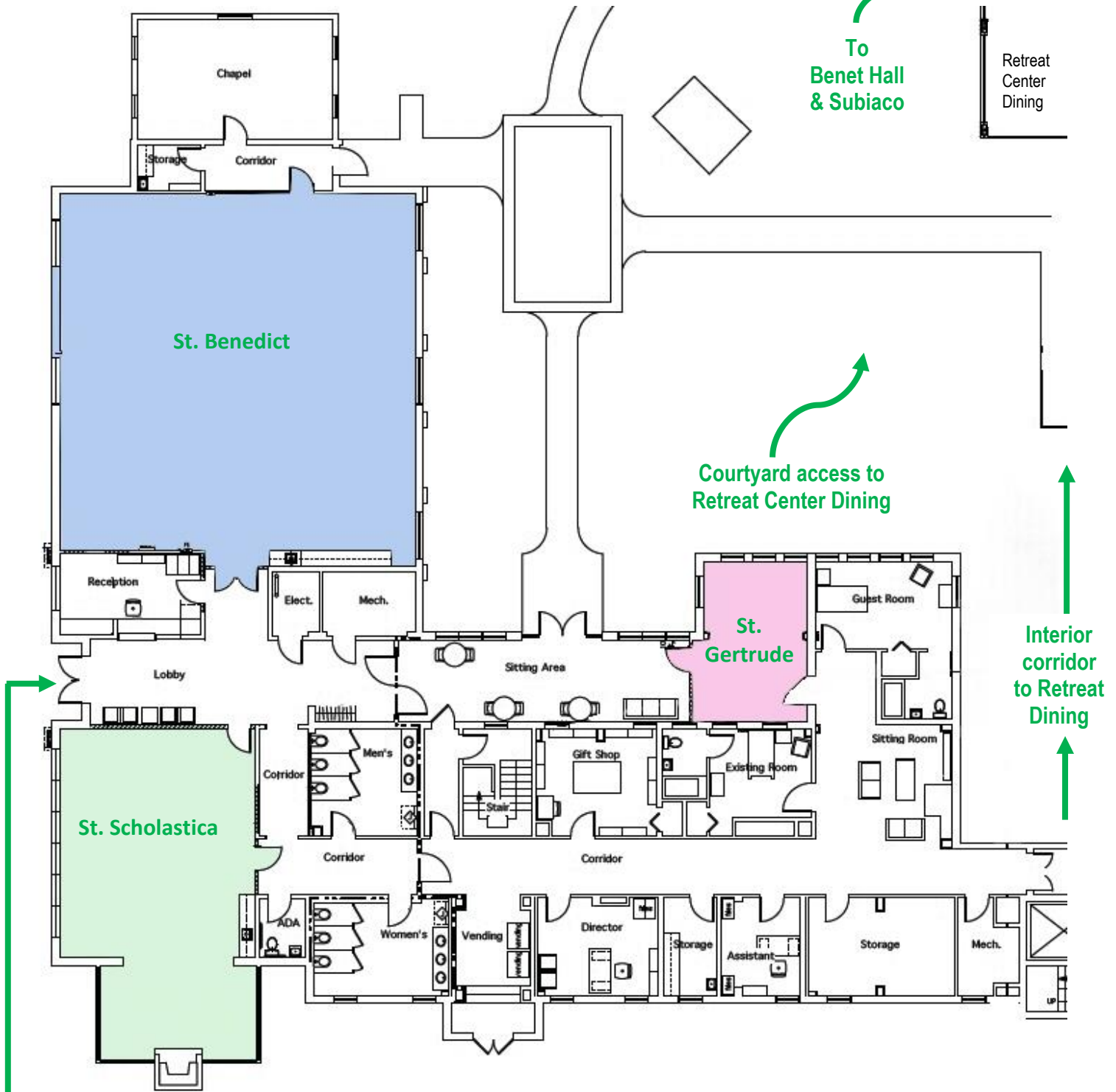
Benedictine Sisters Retreat Center Meeting Room Diagram
